

## Neuro Stockholm opens applications for research grants 2025

Every year, Neuro Stockholm awards a scholarship for patient-centered research in Neurology, which is conducted within the region.

The scholarship is awarded this year to two researchers and is worth SEK 250,000 each.

### Rules for the application

- The application must be presented in Swedish in a popular science format, max. 2 A4 pages (please attach a list of previously published articles)
- The applicant researcher must have an approved research project
- The project or applicant must have a research account
- The research must have a clear connection to Neurological research in adults
- The grantee must be prepared to give a general themed lecture about their project during the coming year, within the framework of Neuro Stockholm's lecture series
- We will not consider applications that concern Alzheimer's or similar cognitive diagnoses
- We will reward research on the effects of climate care

### Selection

The two Fellows are selected by the Neuro Stockholm board, all of whom are laypeople in neurology and do not have any more in-depth knowledge of neurological research. Hence the requirement that the application/research be presented in a popular science format.

The scholarship will be awarded at a small ceremony in connection with our celebration of Neuro Day. Date to be announced.
