

## Neuroförbundet Stockholm opens applications for research grants 2026

Every year, Neuro Stockholm awards a scholarship for patient-centered research in Neurology, which is conducted within the region.

The scholarship is awarded this year to two researchers and is worth SEK 250,000 each.

### Rules for the application

- The application must be submitted in Swedish and written in a popular science format. The presentation should be no longer than 2 A4 pages (a list of publications may be submitted in addition to the two pages not to be exceeded by the application).
- Eligibility to apply is granted to researchers with a research account administered by a research institute.
- Applicants for research funding must have an approved ethical application decision before submitting an application for research grants from Neuroförbundet Stockholm (Hofgrens fund).
- The research must have a clear connection to neurological research in adults.
- The scholarship holder must be prepared to give a general themed lecture about their project during the coming year, as part of the Neuroförbundet Stockholm lecture series.
- We will not consider applications that concern Alzheimer's or similar cognitive diagnoses.

### Selection

The two Fellows are selected by the Neuro Stockholm board, all of whom are laypeople in neurology and do not have any more in-depth knowledge of neurological research. Hence the requirement that the application/research be presented in a popular science format.

The scholarship will be awarded at a small ceremony in connection with our celebration of Neuro Day. Date to be announced.
